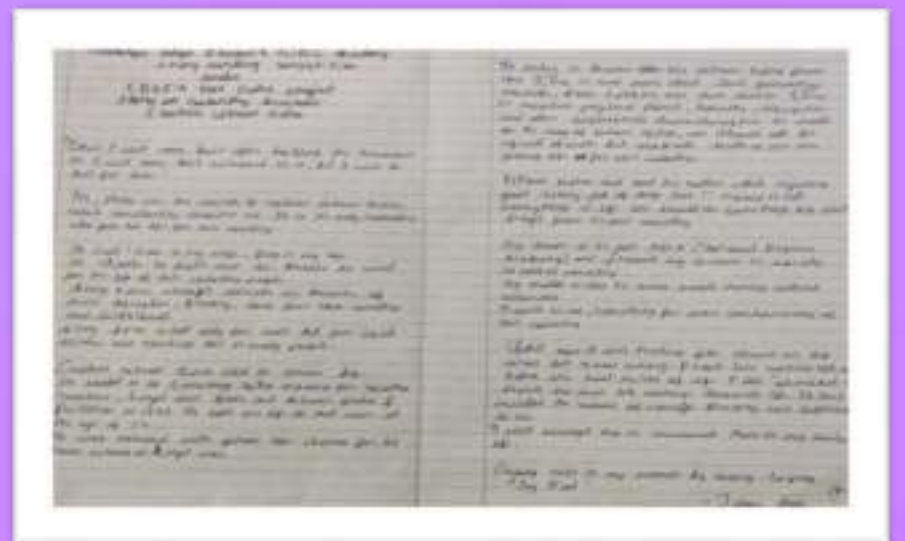
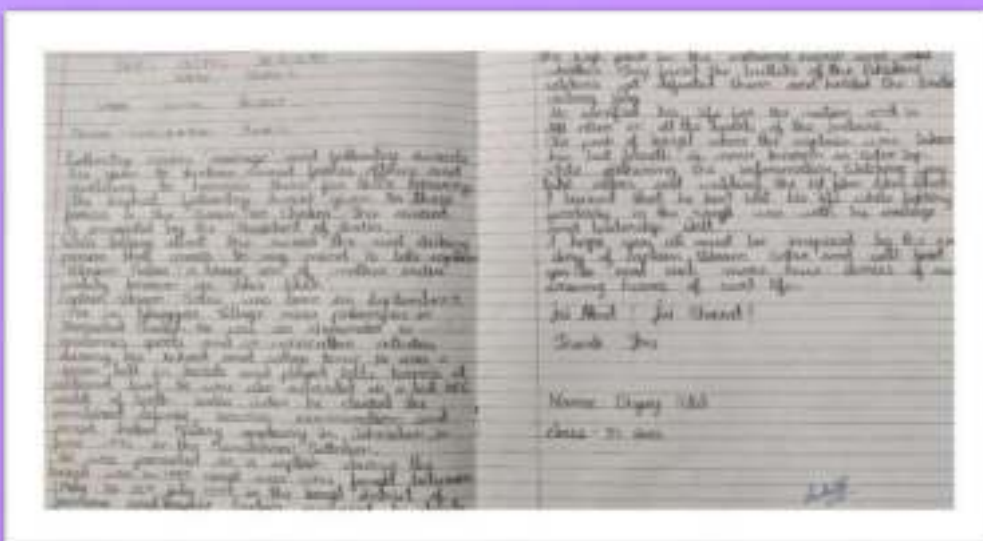

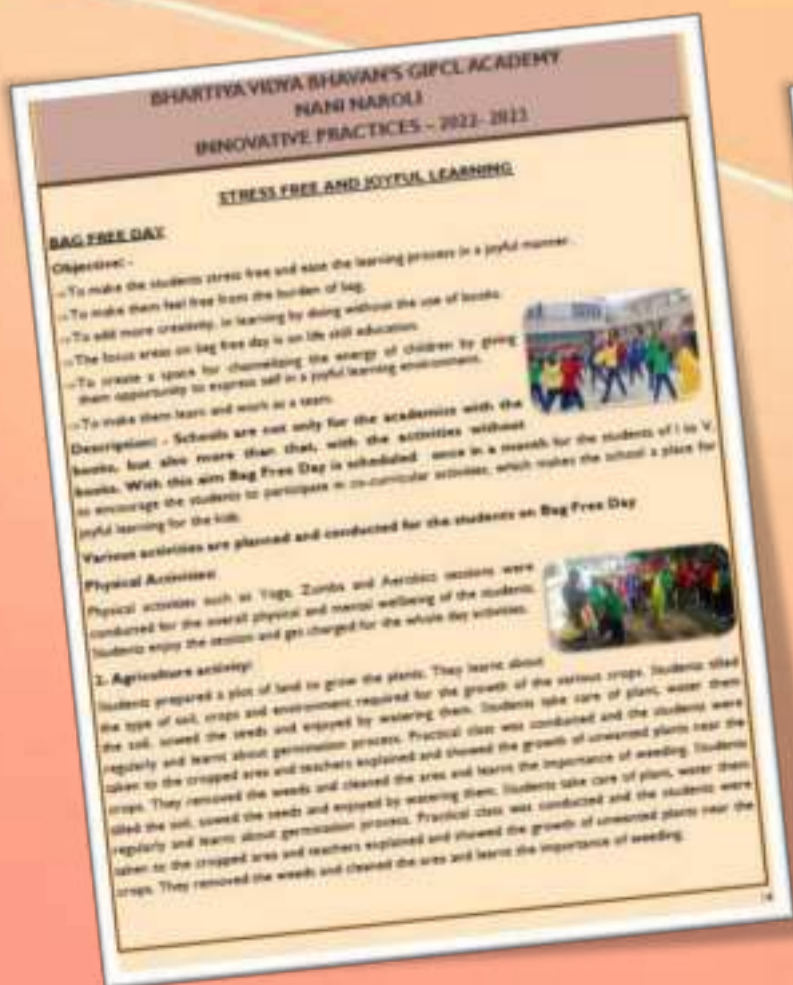
SPOT LIGHT EVENT
