**Inter-House Science :** The Inter House Science Quiz was conducted by the Science Department to foster scientific inquiry, analytical thinking, and problem-solving skills among students. # Day Celebrations

**World Heritage Day:** To raise awareness about cultural heritage and its preservation, the Social Science Department organized a special morning assembly for World Heritage Day. Student introduced the event and delivered a speech on its significance. They also discussed seven world heritage sites, including the Great Wall of China, Chichen Itza, and the Taj Mahal. An India Heritage Quiz was conducted for students from Std. I to XII. Principal Shri Vaibhav Agarwal highlighted India's 200 heritage sites, emphasizing six UNESCO cultural heritage sites in Gujarat, such as Dholavira and the Statue of Unity. He stressed the responsibility of preserving historic structures and commended students for their efforts in the program.

**World Book Day:** World Book Day, celebrated globally on April 23rd, promotes reading culture and fosters a habit of reading for pleasure. Designated by UNESCO, the day highlights the role of books in education, entertainment, and cultural enrichment.

To encourage reading among students and enhance literacy, a Special Assembly was organized for Std. I to XII and staff members. A 30-minute book reading session allowed students to explore books on moral values, short stories from Jataka Tales and Panchatantra, biographies of great personalities, and informative encyclopaedias on topics like the Plant Kingdom and the Universe.

# Day Celebrations

**Independence Day:** Independence Day was celebrated with patriotic fervor to educate students about India's freedom struggle and instill respect for national symbols.
